Whereas the Government of Canada wishes to ensure that its policy objective of restoring and maintaining traditional rural mail delivery is met;

And whereas the Minister of Transport, Infrastructure and Communities, as the appropriate Minister, has consulted the board of directors of Canada Post Corporation with respect to the content and effect of this directive;

Therefore, Her Excellency the Governor General in Council, being of the opinion that it is in the public interest, on the recommendation of the Minister of Transport, Infrastructure and Communities, pursuant to section 89 of the *Financial Administration Act*, hereby directs Canada Post Corporation to deliver mail at rural roadside mail boxes that were serviced by that Corporation on September 1, 2005, while respecting all applicable laws and, for the purposes of that delivery service, to develop and provide to the appropriate Minister, within 14 days after the day on which this directive is given, and implement, as soon as practicable but in any event within 18 months after that day, an operational plan that deals, at reasonable costs, with all relevant issues, including by means of consultations with customers and stakeholders, and that provides for quarterly milestones and reporting to the appropriate Minister on the progress made and the costs incurred by Canada Post Corporation in implementing this directive.
