I am happy that Canada Post has “temporarily” suspended its decision to end home mail delivery, but I would like to see a permanent halt to the delivery cuts. I would also like the post office to restore delivery to people who have lost it since the cuts were announced in 2013.

I think it’s high time for a public review of Canada Post that allows us to consider these moves and others. We need a public review to discuss the future and our options for building a successful 21st century post office with the ability to create new revenue streams and meet the needs of Canadians. For example, Canada Post could add lucrative postal banking services. Postal banking helps keep postal services viable and financial services accessible in many parts of the world. Why not here?

Please urge the Minister responsible for Canada Post to conduct a public review of our postal service, including consideration of postal banking.
